Kansas City, Missouri

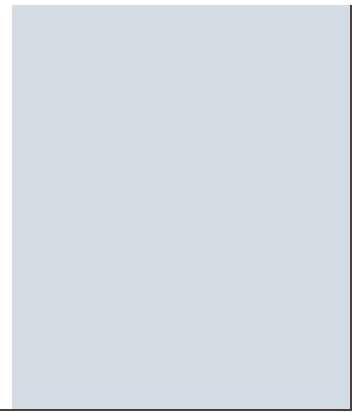
